SCHOLARSHIP AWARD**

Purpose: The Scholarship Program is designed to assist graduating high school seniors who are planning to attend Fayetteville State University (FSU) and continuing students who are pursuing a college degree at FSU, Fayetteville, North Carolina. It is also designed to encourage academic excellence and active participation in the community and the FSU Alumni Association upon graduation.

Application Procedures: Current Recipients

- 1. An announcement of the procedures and an application for applying for a Scholarship Award will be provided by the D.C. Chapter FSU National Alumni association (DCCFSUNAA) to High Schools located in the Washington, D.C. Metro Area and to students currently enrolled at FSU who desire financial assistance.**
- 2. The D.C. FSUNAA Scholarship Award will usually be made available for the fall semester of the proceeding school year.**
- 3. The size of the scholarship award will be determined by the resources available and the number of qualified applicants.**
- 4. Scholarships will be awarded based on a variety of factors, to include academic achievement, financial need, community involvement and other factors as deemed appropriate by the Alumni Association. Applications will be reviewed by the Scholarship Committee and will be approved by the DCCFSUNAA.**
- 5. The application prescribed by the Alumni Association must be completed by a student each year in which consideration for a Scholarship Award is desired. Scholarships are awarded on a one-time, non renewable basis, and recipients must be enrolled as full-time students at FSU.**
- 6. Scholarship Award recipients must sign a written agreement pledging to support the local FSU Chapter upon graduation.**

Criteria:

- 1. Applicants must be attending Fayetteville State University (FSU) on a full-time basis.**
- 2. Applicants must submit a completed application and all required documents to the D.C. Chapter FSUNAA Scholarship by the deadline date indicated on the announcement and/or application. The application package must include an official copy of the student's transcript. Incomplete or late applications will be disqualified.**
- 3. Students currently enrolled at FSU must maintain a minimum GPA of 2.50 on a 4.00 scale in order to receive scholarship awards.**
- 4. The Award must be used for undergraduate studies not to exceed four (4) years.**
- 5. Attendance must be full-time.**

- 2. The D.C. FSUNAA Scholarship Award will usually be made available for the fall semester of the proceeding school year.**
- 3. The size of the scholarship award will be determined by the resources available and the number of qualified applicants.**
- 4. Scholarships will be awarded based on a variety of factors, to include academic achievement, financial need, community involvement and other factors as deemed appropriate by the Alumni Association. Applications will be reviewed by the Scholarship Committee and will be approved by the DCCFSUNAA.**
- 5. The application prescribed by the Alumni Association must be completed by a student each year in which consideration for a Scholarship Award is desired. Scholarships are awarded on a one-time, non renewable basis, and recipients must be enrolled as full-time students at FSU.**
- 6. Scholarship Award recipients must sign a written agreement pledging to support the local FSU Chapter upon graduation.**

Criteria:

- 1. Applicants must provide written proof of acceptance to Fayetteville State University (FSU).**
- 2. Applicants must submit a completed application and all required documents to the DCCFSUNAA by the deadline date indicated on the announcement and/or application. The application package must include an official copy of the student's transcript, and test scores on the SAT, ACT, and AP as appropriate. Incomplete or late applications will be disqualified.**
- 3. Applicants must submit two (2) letters of recommendation and an essay of no more than one (1) page on the topic, "Why I Would Like to Attend College and My Career Goals and Aspirations".**
- 4. Students currently enrolled at FSU must maintain a minimum GPA of 2.50 on a 4.00 scale in order to receive scholarship awards.**
- 5. The Award must be used for undergraduate studies not to exceed four (4) years.**
- 6. Attendance must be full-time.**
